## Operational Updates

- Barring unforeseen circumstances, OCME
  Operations will return to normal on JUNE 1, 2021
  - OCME BCP Taskforce will be demobilized.
  - OCME BCP Coordinators will return to their pre-Covid agency roles and be unavailable to support with case reporting.
  - Hospital Morgue Census Survey no longer required after June 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - For assistance with cases please continue to call the OCME general number at 212-447-2030 and follow the prompts for medical facilities.

## Operational Updates

- At this time, OCME will be re-implementing the 7-day hold for all claim only cases starting JUNE 1, 2021.
  - This hold does not apply to Medical Examiner cases, which will continue to be picked up upon successful reporting and submission of necessary paperwork.
- Hospitals should utilize internal fatality management plans and pre-defined triggers to activate internal surge space or private resources should the need arise.
