- Savannah was a Christmas gift to President Lincoln during the Civil War
- Savannah's First African Baptist Church was the first black church in the country.
- Moon River Brewing Company is considered by many as the most haunted site in Savannah.
- The Girl Scouts was founded in Savannah at The Juliette Gordon Low House.
- Savannah is one of the few cities you can take your cocktails to-go.
- Savannah was the first planned city in the country and the first city in Georgia.
- Savannah's port is the 4th busiest port in the US (2nd busiest on the east coast).
- Savannah has one of the prettiest streets in America, Jones Street in the historic district.
- Savannah is home to one of the oldest operating theaters in the US, The Savannah Theater.
- Forrest Gump was filmed in Savannah and the bench where Tom Hanks sat was in Chippewa Square. The bench is now on display at Savannah History Museum.
- Savannah hosts the 2nd-3rd largest annual St. Patrick's Parade in the US, brining hundreds of thousands of patrons and partygoers to the area every March.
- Leopold's Ice Cream (on Broughton Street) is named as one of the Top 10 ice cream parlors in the world. It was founded in 1919, current owner Stratton Leopold is also a Hollywood producer.
